Route: Manali - Chandratal - Kaza - Tabo - Gue - Pin valley

**Duration:** 6 Nights 7 Days

#### Day 1

# Manali to Kaza | via Kunzom pass (14,931 ft) See the first village of the Spiti valley, the Losar village

- After breakfast, set off from Manali toward Kaza; the journey unveils breathtaking landscapes and thrilling adventures ahead.
- Through the Atal Tunnel, reach Chatru and Batal and encounter Lahaul's unique green terrain, a precursor to its stunning beauty.
- Then, pass through Kunzum Pass (14,931 ft) that connects Lahaul Valley to Spiti Valley & descend towards Losar Village, your first taste of Spiti's charm.
- Stopover at Losar to savor hot tea, and relish local snacks before resuming your exhilarating journey.
- Energized, drive through captivating vistas to Kaza, where Spiti's vibrant culture and breathtaking landscapes welcome you.

### Day 2

# Sightseeing around Kaza | Visit the world's Hightest Post Office in Hikkim

Start with a hearty breakfast before exploring these high-altitude wonders,
venturing to some of the world's highest inhabited areas.

- Visit Asia's highest village, Komik, named "eye of a snow cock" and take in the panoramic vistas of the Himalayas.
- Head to Hikkim Village, home to the world's highest post office and send postcards to your loved ones.
- Explore Langza, which houses the ancient Lang Temple dating back 1000 years, then return to Kaza for lunch.
- After lunch, proceed to the iconic Key Monastery, and walk through it's beautifully painted galleries.
- Continue your journey to Kibber, a picturesque village with panoramic landscapes and breathtaking mountain views.
- Conclude the tour by visiting Gette, a secluded village offering stunning aerial vistas of Kaza. Capture the beauty and tie prayer flags.

#### Day 3

### **Kaza to tabo | via Dhankhar Monastery**

- Begin with an early breakfast, and then leave for Tabo.
- Visit the 1020-year-old Tabo Monastery, a UNESCO world heritage site known for unique art blending Tibetan, Indian, and Kashmiri styles.
- From Tabo, take a detour towards Dhankar village, perched high above the Spiti and Pin River confluence.
- If time permits, hike to Dhankar Tso, a stunning turquoise lake offering panoramic valley views.
- Night stay at Tabo.

#### Day 4

#### **Tabo to Gue Monastery | with Pin valley**

- Begin with early breakfast, and then leave for Gue monastery.
- Then tracing back to tabo, take a tea break.
- Next, drive to scenic Pin Valley, a national park teeming with rare animals, birds, and vibrant plant species.
- If you are lucky enough you can spot the beautiful snow leopards at the park.
- Explore Kungri Monastery and reach Mudh, Pin Valley's last motorable village.
- Be enchanted by the skies painted with pika, golden eagles, bearded vultures, and more as you journey through Pin Valley.

#### Day 5

#### Pin valley to Kaza

- After breakfast, and leave for kaza.
- Take a turn from lidang village to Demul road.
- After break at top off Demul, then take a road for hikkim.
- Night stay in kaza

#### Day 6

## Kaza to Chandratal lake | explore lake that changes colours throughout the day

- Start your journey back after breakfast, retracing the Kaza-Manali road's scenic beauty, through the beautiful Kunzum-Pass.
- On the return, detour to Chandratal Lake, a Spiti gem nestled at around 14,100 feet, surrounded by majestic peaks.

- Chandratal, set against the Chandra Bhaga range, changes with the light, showcasing mesmerizing reflections and hues throughout the day.
- Capture Chandratal's beauty, then descend to your campsite for a hot supper under the sparkling Himalayan stars.

### Day 7

## **Chandratal to Manali | via Rohtang pass**

- After breakfast at camp site, and then leave back to manali.
- Night stay at manali or depart to Delhi.
