Route: Manali – Atal Tunnel – Sissu – Keylong – Jispa – Darcha – Shinkula pass - Gombo Rangjon - Phuktal Monastery – Padum – Sani monastery – Karsha monastery – Stongde monastery – Bardan monastery – Shila waterfall

Duration: 5 Nights 6 Days

Start Point : Manali End Point : Manali

Day 1

Manali to Jispa via solang valley | Capture the Spectacular view of Dhundi and cover Atal tunnel is the world's longest highway tunnel above 10,000 ft

- You will be passing through the atal tunnel under the famous Rohtang pass and then drive into the stunning views of sissu waterfall.
- Take a short stopover at Sissu lake and enjoy the hot cup of tea and some snacks.
- Having warmed up with a cup of tea, you will continue driving through the stunning view of Lady of keylong and reach Jispa.
- You will be spending the night at a comfortable hotel in Jispa.

Day 2

Jispa to Gombo Rangjon | Having a breakfast you will cross the scenic shinkula pass located at over 5000 meters altitude before descending into Zanskar Valley.

- Enjoy the breakfast before you drive to some of the highest inhabited regions of the world
- Gombo rangjon is stand alone lofty rocky precipice located south of Kargyak village in the Lungnak valley, Zanskar, in the Union Territory of Ladakh in india
- Will the visuals of the stunning gombo rangjon peak captured in the minds and cameras.
- Night stay at camps near mighty mountain

Day 3

Gombo Rangjon to Phuktal Monastery | Capture the Spectacular view of Gombo Ranjon mountain.

- You will reach at khangsar village
- There is 45 minute track to reach Phuktal monastery
- Before we take a turn and the majestic monastery on the side of a cliff, comes into view.
- The monastery is located inside a huge cave and is one of its kind.
- You will continue tracing your steps back towards Purne
- Night stay at Purne village

Day 4

Phuktal Monastery | to Padum is the main town and the administrative centre of the Zanskar tehsil in Kargil district, Ladakh

- Having breakfast at purne then you will drive through the most rugged mountains on the way
- Soon after one can get the serene Maitreya Buddha statue at Ichar village
- A short drive take us to the Raru village.
- After few miles we spot the Bardan Monastery from the highway, perched atop a cliff.
- Night stay at padum.

Day 5

Explore the Padum | it's a day to relax and take in the majestic views of the valley.

- We begin the day with a visit to the picturesque Shila Waterfall.
- We will spend the later half of the day exploring the ancient monasteries around the Padum.
- Karsha monastery, the largest monastery of the region perhed on the side of a mountain, where you can see a well preserved mummy.
- We the head further down the valley to Stongde Monastery.

- After lunch we drive on the Padum-Kargil road to see the most majestic sights.
- Just a few minutes outside Padum is the holy Sani Lake with the statue of Guru Padamsambhawa.

Day 6

Padum to manali | on the final day, we drive back to manali.

- Retracing our toute over the Shinkula pass and passing through Darcha and Jispa.
- The journey brings you full circle, offering a final chance to savor the breathtaking views and reflect on the incredible experiences of your trip.
- We should arrive in Manali by late afternoon. If you plan to leave Manali the same evening, we recommend booking you transportation after 8pm.
